



Skerries Community College

Policy on Enrolment

This policy commences for enrolment into First year 2012/13 and replaces all previous enrolment policies.

The closing date for receipt of applications for First Year is the second Friday in November prior to year of entry. All applications received after that date will be placed in Category 7 below and will be dealt with in strict date order.

Places in first year will be allocated in order by the following categories, commencing with Category 1:

Category 1.

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who

- are students in one of the feeder schools (as defined in appendix A below)

AND

- are permanent, verified residents in the catchment area (as defined in the accompanying map in appendix B below)

AND

- have a sibling attending the College in, at least, the year prior to entry.

Category 2.

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who

- are students in one of the feeder schools (as defined in appendix A below)

AND

- are permanent, verified residents in the catchment area (as defined in the accompanying map in appendix B below).

Category 3.

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who

- are students in one of the feeder schools (as defined in Appendix A below)

AND

- have a sibling attending the College in, at least, the year prior to entry.

Category 4.

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who

- are permanent, verified residents in the catchment area (as defined in the accompanying map in appendix B below)

AND

- have a sibling attending the College in, at least, the year prior to entry.

Category 5.

- All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who are students in one of the feeder schools (as defined in appendix A below)

OR

- All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who are permanent, verified residents in the catchment area (as defined in the accompanying map in appendix B below).

OR

- All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who have a sibling attending the College in, at least, the year prior to entry.

Category 6.

All applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form who are students in Lusk schools (Lusk NS, Corduff NS, Hedgestown NS, Rush & Lusk Educate Together).

Category 7.

All other applicants who have applied on the official College Application Form.

Where the number of applicants in any category is sufficient to exceed the maximum number of places available in the College a lottery will be held for all the applicants in that category. The enrolment process for all other categories ends at this point.

The lottery will be held in public and supervised by an independent party. A waiting list will be made up from the unsuccessful applicants in the order as they came in the lottery draw. This waiting list will remain in place until the second Friday of November in the year of entry.
